

# Rafting on the Urubamba River and tour to the Queswachaca Bridge

(2d/1n)



Live the emotion and the living history! Enjoy the fun class III and III + rapids of the Urubamba River in the morning and a relaxing afternoon at Cusipata River Lodge. This great adventure also takes you to live the history in the construction of the Queswachaca bridge that has been carried out every year since the time of the Incas, respecting its ancestral engineering.

## ITINERARY

### Day 01

- 1** Cusco Rafting river Urubamba Chuquicahuana night Cusipata Lodge  
We will pick you up at 8:30 AM from your hotel in Cusco. Our tourist service bus will take you to the south of Cusco, to the town of Cusipata; the transfer lasts an average of 1 hour and 30 minutes on the Cusco-Sicuani highway.
- 2** We will arrive at our destination "Cusipata River Lodge", where you will find all the facilities such as: toilets, dressing rooms, sauna, lockers and all the boating equipment will be provided, such as: helmet, life jacket, wetsuit and a waterproof jacket.
- 3** Then the guides will provide you with all the necessary information and we will proceed with the tour of the river in self-evacuating inflatable rafts for an average of 2 hours. The rapids in this section are Class III and III + - we also send a safety kayaker.

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## Day 02

- 4 At the end of the Rafting, you will return to "Cusipata River Lodge", where you can relax in our sauna and then have a delicious lunch in our dining room (Option: vegetarian lunch).
- 5 Then the guides will provide you with all the necessary equipment and information to ride the zip line that consists of 2 cables of 100 meters long each crossing over the beautiful waters of the river. Then you will spend the rest of the afternoon at the lodge where we will provide dinner campfires and spend the night in double or multi-bed rooms. (L + D).
- 1 **Puente de Qeswaschaca and 4 Lagoons**  
After enjoying a delicious breakfast, we will leave the lodge at 5:30 in the morning; from here our first stop will be in the town of Combapata.
- 2 Here we will visit the first Pomacanchis lagoon, part of the 4 lagoons circuit, from where we will enjoy impressive views and take many photos. Then we will pass through the Acopia, Asnaqocha and Pampamarca lagoons, places where we will appreciate the typical flora and fauna of each lagoon.
- 3 After taking pictures and continuing with the tour, we will pass through the Yanaoca district, one of the eight districts of the Canas province in Cusco.
- 4 Continuing our journey for one more hour we will then reach the district of Q'ewe where the famous Inca bridge of "Qeswachaka" is located, which is built from vegetable fiber and has a length of 28.67 meters.
- 5 Throughout the trip our guide will narrate the history of this work of Inca engineering. You can also cross the Qeswachaca bridge, which has a length of 28.5 meters, but it is a requirement that you not suffer from vertigo.
- 6 At the end of the visit we will take the way back to our private lodge where a succulent lunch will await us; you can also enjoy our sauna to recharge your batteries and then return to Cusco at approximately 5:30 pm

### RECOMMENDATIONS

- Appropriate clothing for walking, comfortable shoes and a rain poncho
- A bottle of water and any personal medications
- Items to protect yourself from the sun (sunglasses, hat or sun hats)
- Extra cash, for your personal spending
- Sunscreen, camera and video camera
